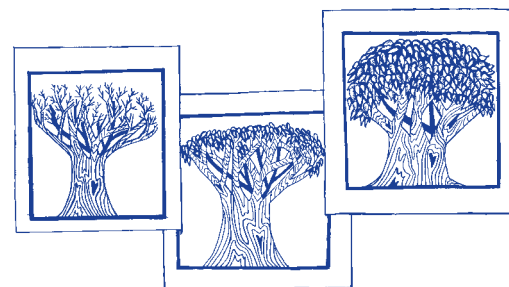


## Lectionary Readings

The following readings and psalms are provided for use at the Easter Vigil. A minimum of three Old Testament readings should be chosen. Ordinarily, Exodus 14 is included.

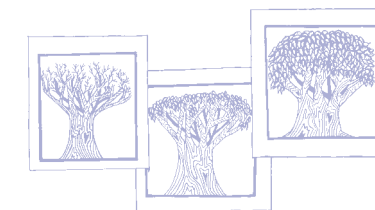
Genesis 1:1-2:4a Psalm 136:1-9, 23-36	God creates, declares creation good, and rests on the seventh day. Give thanks to God, who creates out of steadfast love.
Genesis 7:1-5, 11-18; 8:6-18; 9:8-13 Psalm 46	Noah, his family, and pairs of animals endure a forty-day flood. The psalmist sings of God's faithfulness in every circumstance.
Genesis 22:1-18 Psalm 16	Abraham prepares to sacrifice Isaac, but God intervenes. The psalmist prays for protection and blesses God for assistance.
Exodus 14:10-31; 15:20-21 Exodus 15, 1b-13, 17-18	The Israelites are freed from Egypt by crossing the Red Sea. The Israelites sing of God's victory and their liberation.
Isaiah 55:1-11 Isaiah 12:2-6	God invites Israel to the abundance of life in God's covenant. The people will sing praises to God for their salvation.
Baruch 3:9-15, 3:32-4:4 Proverbs 8:1-8, 19-21; 9:4b-6 Psalm 19	God gives wisdom as a gift to God's people. Wisdom calls to the people and invites them to her way of life. All creation proclaims God's glory. God's law is perfect.
Ezekiel 36:24-28 Psalms 42 and 43	God promises to gather, cleanse, and inspire God's people. The psalmist longs for God and asks for God's vindication.
Ezekiel 37:1-14 Psalm 143	A valley full of dry bones is revived by the breath of God. The psalmist prays to be heard by God and guided in God's will.
Zephaniah 3:14-20 Psalm 98	The Lord is in the midst of Israel and will bring them home. Sing a new song to the Lord and make a joyful noise.
Romans 6:3-11 Psalm 114	In baptism we are united to Christ's death and resurrection. Creation is moved by God's work of liberation.
Mark 16:1-8	Women go to Jesus' tomb and find it empty.
